INVITES APPLICATIONS FROM UNMARRIED MALE CANDIDATES FOR SELECTION TEST IN NOVEMBER 2009 TO JOIN AS AN AIRMAN IN GROUP 'X' (TECHNICAL) TRADES

1. Indian Air Force invites applications from unmarried male Indian citizens (citizens of Nepal are also eligible) for selection as an Airman in Group 'X' (Technical) trades. THE RECRUITMENT TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS OFFICERS, PILOTS/NAVIGATORS.

2. **Qualification.** Candidate should have passed Intermediate/10+2 with pass marks in Mathematics and Physics with a minimum of 50% marks in overall aggregate.

OR
Should have passed a 3 year Diploma course in Engineering (Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics/Automobile/Computer Science/Instrumentation Technology/Information Technology) with at least 50% marks from a Govt. recognised Polytechnic Institute.

3. President, Central Airmen Selection Board reserves the right to shortlist the applications on the basis of available vacancies and number of eligible applicants.

4. **Age.** Born between 01 January 1999 and 28 February 1993 (both days inclusive).

5. **Medical Standards** (a) Height: Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cm (b) Chest: Minimum range of expansion: 5 cm (c) Weight: Proportionate to height and age. (d) Vision: Minimum Visual Standard: Unaided 6/36, corrected to at least 6/9 each eye with spectacles, Diopteric power not exceeding ± 3.5 Dioptres in any axis. Full field of vision and Defective safe colour vision CP-II / III. (Candidate should bring latest prescription and spectacles for correction, if used). (e) Corneal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable. (f) Hearing: Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear a soft whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (g) Dental: Should have healthy gums, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (h) Health: Candidate should be free from medical or surgical deformity. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidates must be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, climate and terrain.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

6. **Tenure & Training.** Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years. Initially, candidates will be sent for Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) for 12 weeks at Basic Training Institute Belgaum (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be allocated trades and sent for trade training of specified durations. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be medically unfit. AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING, THE AIRMEN WILL BE DEPLOYED ON GROUND BASED JOBS AS PER THEIR ALLOTTED TRADES.

7. **Pay & Allowances.** During training a stipend of Rs. 5,700/-pm will be paid. On completion of training, starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay will be Rs. 14,460/-pm (approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise up to Rs 26,300/- pm (approximately) depending upon the rank attained. In addition, perks such as Ration, Clothing, Medical Facilities, Accommodation, Leave Travel Concession (LTC) etc. are also provided as per the existing rules.

8. **Promotion.** Promotion prospects exist up to the rank of Master Warrant Officer (MWO). Opportunities to become a Commissioned Officer also exist for those airmen who qualify the prescribed examinations, later during their service career.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

9. **Written Test.** Eligible candidates will be sent Admit Cards to appear for the tests scheduled to be held during November 2009 at the examination centres listed at para 16. Candidates will be tested in English, Physics & Mathematics based on CBSE syllabus of All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISCE). Question papers will be of objective type and bilingual (English & Hindi) except English Paper. Duration of Written Test will be 60 minutes. CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER SEPARATELY. Results of the written test will be declared on the same day.

10. **Physical Fitness Test (PFT).** All candidates who pass the written test are to undergo Physical Fitness Test (PFT) on the same or the next day. PFT consists of a 1.6 Km run to be completed within 8 minutes. Candidates completing the PFT in less than 7 minutes 30 seconds will be awarded additional marks on a sliding scale. Candidates are advised to bring their own sports shoes and shorts.

11. **Interview.** Candidates who have passed the written test and PFT will be interviewed. Working knowledge of English is a prerequisite.

12. **Trade Allocation Test (TAT).** Candidates who qualify in interview are to undergo Trade Test for bifurcation into Mechanical and Electronics stream. Specific trade allotment within these stream will be carried out at Basic Training Institute (BTI) Air Force Belgaum, Karnataka.

13. **MEDICAL EXAMINATION.** Candidates who qualify in the interview will be medically examined. Medical Examination will be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per IAF medical standards. Candidates declared Temporary Medically Unfit will be required to report to the respective Airmen Selection Centre within a maximum period of 42 days for review from the date of Recruiting Medical Examination. Candidates declared Medically Unfit can avail the option for Appeal Medical Board (AMB) against their Unfitness by depositing Rs. 40/- in a Government Treasury Receipt through Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of MRO, Xerox copy of Unfitness Certificate and Postal Stamp worth Rs. 25/- affixed on a self addressed envelope are to be submitted to the respective ASC for processing within seven working days from the date of issue of Medical Certificate.

NOTE :- Candidates are advised to get tartar & stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the written test. Ears should be free of wax.

GENERAL

14. (a) Candidates must indicate three choices of the examination centre in order of preference. However, Central Airmen Selection Board reserves the right to allot any centre other than those mentioned in the application. (b) REQUESTS FOR CHANGE OF EXAMINATION CENTRE OR DATE OF SELECTION TEST WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED. (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date and time will not be accommodated on other dates/shifts. (d) Incomplete applications will be rejected. (e) Candidates should be prepared to stay for the entire duration of the tests under their own arrangement. No TA/DA will be admissible. (f) Upper age limit as on date of enrolment is 22 years.

15. Candidate declared Permanently Medically Unfit by any Armed Forces Hospital or discharged from the Indian Air Force/Indian Army/Indian Navy or dismissed from any Government Organisation for any reason earlier are NOT TO APPLY.

16. **Examination Centres.** Ambala, New Delhi, Kanpur, Barrackpore Jodhpur, Mumbai, Bangalore, Chennai, Bhubaneswar, Bihra Guwahati, Secunderabad, Kochi and Bhopal.

(Note :- These Centres are likely to be activated depending upon the response of candidates and testing capacity).

(a) Three copies of unattested recent (taken on or after 30 June 2009) passport size COLOUR PHOTOGRAPH (front portrait without headgear except for Sikhs), ONE of which is to be pasted on the application form and the other two are to be stapled to the top left corner of the application form. THE PHOTOGRAPH IS TO BE TAKEN WITH CANDIDATE HOLDING A BLACK SLATE IN FRONT OF HIS CHEST WITH HIS NAME, DATE OF BIRTH AND DATE OF PHOTOGRAPH CLEARLY WRITTEN ON IT WITH WHITE CHALK IN CAPITAL LETTERS. Photographs should be only on good quality "Photo Paper".

(b) Attested copies of Matriculation Certificate/Marks Sheet in support of Date of Birth. Attested copies of Marks Sheet & Certificates of Educational Qualification.

(c) One unstamped self addressed 24 cm x 10 cm WHITE ENVELOPE of good quality, stapled/pinned with the application form.

18. Candidates are to bring with them the following at the time of examination.

(a) Four copies of their colour photographs which was submitted at the time of application.

(b) Original Matriculation Certificate and Marks Sheet with three copies of each for verification of date of birth.

(c) Original certificate and marks sheet of Intermediate/10+2/Diploma in Engineering as applicable with three copies of each.

(d) NCC Certificate (A,B, or C only), if applicable (Original & three copies).

(e) Son of Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) Certificate/Discharge Book, if applicable (Original & one copy).

LETTERS. Do not split words. Fill para 2, 'Name of the Candidate' and para 4, 'Date of Birth' as per the examples given below:-

(b) **Calculation of Percentage of Marks.** Exact aggregate percentage of marks up to first two decimal for all subjects as mentioned in the Marks Sheet of Intermediate/10+2/Diploma in Engineering only to be counted for calculating the percentage. For example, 49.9% should NOT be rounded off to 50%.

(c) **Envelope.** Outside the envelope containing the application write clearly (i) "FOR GROUP 'X' (TECHNICAL) TRADES" (ii) "AGGREGATE PERCENTAGE OF MARKS% IN CLASS XII/DIPLOMA" (iii) "Son of Serving/Discharged/Deceased Officer/Airman/NC(E)/Air Force Unit Cadre Civilian - {SOAFP}" (if applicable) to be annotated in RED INK.
