Sri Amitava Sengupta, WBCS (Exe) Additional District Magistrate (G) Birbhum presided over the meeting and initiated discussion by welcoming the Ld. Lawyer(s) of Suri and Dubrajpur Court.

At the outset of the meeting, he expressed the importance of such Co-ordination meeting for smoothly conducting of the prosecution in the Courts as desired by District Magistrate, Birbhum. He also discussed about submission of performance report by the Ld.P.P., Birbhum and panel A.P.Ps.


The following decisions were taken in the meeting:

1. The Ld. P.P and the Ld. APPs will submit report of their performance indicating the sections under which the cases are filed and number of such cases under those specific sections. There is need for record the performance report of Ld. P.P. and A.P.Ps. consequent upon this Panel Lawyer(s)/A.P.P(s) are advised to submit their performance report for the period of 01/01/2010 to 30/06/2010 in the prescribed format by 05/07/2010.
2. The Ld PP informed the house that a lot of cases which are sent to the LR department with suggested appeal and with clarification on the ground of the appeal are not returned to the district even after a long time keeping the lawyer at this end in limbo about the next steps to be taken. It was decided that the Ld. PP will prepare a list of such cases sent to the LR and submit it to the DM, Birbhum for taking up the problem with LR.. Ld L.R. West Bengal will be requested to consider the appeal cases as send from this District to prefer appeal before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, if there is reasonable ground.
3. Ld. P.P. and Ld. A.P.Ps requested the house that remunerations of the Ld. P.P. and Ld. A.P.Ps are paid in due time.
4. The electricity duty cases are not being followed up or contested by the concerned authority and it was decided that the inspector now posted at Bardhaman and in charge of the Birbhum district will be called for a meeting in this connection.

5. The seating arrangement of the Ld. P.P. and Panel A.P.P. may be made in the office room of R.R. & R Department as soon as they shifted in the Goal Market Complex. Officer-in-Charge, J.M. will keep Liaison in the matter with the N.D.C. and O.C. R.R. & R Department.
6. The requisition of stationary articles of the Ld. P.P. and the Panel A.P.P. is to be submitted henceforth in the J.M Section
7. The ~~order bill~~ bill of the Ld .P.P. and Panel A.P.P. is to be submitted in the Nezarth Section by 12/07/2010 positively.
8. The N.D.C. will be requested to take necessary actions for regularization of payments of the Panel Lawyers/A.P.P..
9. The Sub Divisional Officer, Rampurhat & Bolpur are requested to hold similar meeting and send the resolution of the meeting along with the proforma report to this end by 12.7.2010

Finally, the President of the meeting requested to extend their whole hearted co-operation in this perspective.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from their chair.




