Minutes of the meeting in regard to Law & Order and Prosecution cases in the district
held on 07.01.2011 in the Conference Hall of Prashasan Bhaban, Suri, Birbhum.

Dr. Saumitra Mohan, IAS, District Magistrate, Birbhum presided over the meeting.

At the outset of the meeting A.D.M (G), Birbhum read out the previous meeting's minutes dated 24/12/2010 and feed back thereof.

District Magistrate expressed that the performance of the Ld. Panel A.P.P.s and Asstt. A.P.P.s are not satisfactory at all. He said in the meeting that some of the Panel A.P.P.s and Asstt. A.P.P.s are overburdened. So, equal distribution of the cases are required for quick disposal of the cases. As a result Govt. are losing most of the prosecution cases. The matter shall have to be looked into.

In this connection, Ld. P.P. suggested that a notice is to be issued to all the Panel A.P.P.s asking them to submit detailed report in regard to their cases for equal distribution from his end. It is also suggested that the list of cases of WBSedcl will be submitted with report for the information of Electricity Deptt.

S.P., Birbhum stated that most of the cases custodial trial are not made. For example he stated that in a case out of 7 accused, 5 appeared and 2 are not arrested. The warrant of arrest should be issued against the rest 2 within 15 days. Execution report is not received. But the charge sheet should be furnished within 90 days. It is to be looked into. He also stated that the Ld. Court of Rampurhat, Bolpur and Dubrajpur are not issuing warrant of arrest and prosecution attachment is not made too. As a result custodial trial has not been made.


After discussion the following decision were taken in the meeting:-

- 1) Equal distribution of cases is to be made among the Panel A.P.P.s by the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Birbhum with consultation of the ADM (G), Birbhum so that the prosecution cases may be disposed of early.
- 2) Regular monthly meeting will be held in this connection in the District Head Quarter as well as Sub-Divisional level and Quarterly meeting in the District Head Quarter will be held with all A.P.P.s and A.G.P.s of the District.

- 3) Monthly performance report of Panel A.P.P. / A.P.P. will be furnished in detailed in the prescribed format before the date of meeting.
- 4) Appeal will be preferred in the merit cases by the engaged Panel A.P.P. /A.P.P. as soon as possible.
- 5) S.P., Birbhum will advise the I.O. to meet the concerned A.P.P. with their case record in time to brief the case.
- 6) Ld. P.P., Birbhum and A.P.P. of CJM Court and ADM (G) will attend the meeting of S.P., Birbhum in crime conference. The Panel A.P.P.s will submit their report to the Ld. P.P. by 20/01/2011 positively and this will be submitted by Ld. P.P. to this office by 28/01/2011.
- 7) Sitting arrangement of the Ld. Panel A.P.P.s will be made as soon as possible and the payment of their due bill will also be made as soon as fund is received from the Govt..
- 8) Contact No. in Mobile and Land Ph. with the name of Ld. P.P., Ld. A.G.P.s, A.P.P.s, Panel A.P.P.s, Ld. Judges, and Executive Magistrate will be collected by Sri Pankaj Kr. Chandra, WBCS (Exe), O/C R.M. and he will prepare a diary by 15/01/2011 positively.
- 9) The Next monthly meeting will held on 07/02/2011 at 03: 00 P.M. in the Conference Hall Prashan Bhaban which will be presided over by the District Magistrate, Birbhum.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.


