Dr. Saumitra Mohan, IAS, District Magistrate, Birbhum presided over the meeting.
At the outset of the meeting D.M, Birbhum read out the previous meeting's minutes dated 15/02/2011 and feed back thereof.

District Magistrate, Birbhum reviewed the performance report of the Asstt. P.P., Panel A.P.P & A.G.P.s who furnished their report for the month of Jan & Feb'2011.

Cases of Asstt. P.P. viz. Fazlur Rahaman, Chandra Nath Goswami and others are pending more which is to be disposed of as early as possible. To remove their overburden, addl. Panel A.P.P.s may be engaged with them by D.M., Birbhum after receiving specific proposal from the Ld. P.P.. In this connection, Ld. P.P. said that the pending cases could be disposed of if the no. of Judges and Courts would increase.

Equal distribution of the cases among the Panel A.P.P.s have not been made till date which would be made very soon by the Ld. P.P. .

Performance report of most of the Panel A.P.P.s and Asstt. A.P.P.s of Rampurhat, Bolpur and Sadar Sub-division Court have been received except for the following A.P.P.s & A.G.P.s. It is also discussed that the Investigating Officers of the concerned cases are not producing CD in time to the concerned Panel P.P. / A.P.P.s. That's why they are facing much trouble to defend those cases at the time of hearing.

Presence of I.O. is very much important at the time of trial. In this connection, S.P. will look into the matter.

Sub-divisional level meeting with the Panel A.P.P.s and A.G.P.s have not been reported by the S.D.O. Bolpur and Rampurhat as per decision of the meeting dated 15/02/2011. A report may be obtained from the S.D.O. Bolpur and Rampurhat in this regard.

After discussion the following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

- 1) Equal distribution of cases is to be made among the Panel A.P.P.s by the Ld. Public Prosecutor, Birbhum within the month of March 2011 and a report in this respect should be furnished by Ld.P.P. to A.D.M. (G).
- 2) Similar monthly meeting will also be held in this connection in the Sub-Divisional level and minutes of the said meeting should be furnished by the S.D.O. Rampurhat and Bolpur to this office regularly along with the performance report of the Panel A.P.P.s and A.G.P.s.
- 3) Show cause notice will be issued against the Panel A.P.P.s and A.G.P.s who have not furnished their performance report for the month of Jan & Feb'2011 within 10/03/2011.
- 4) I.O.s of the concerned cases should produce the CD to the concerned Panel A.P.P.s or P.P. in time and they will render all possible help to defend the case. S.P., Birbhum will look into the matter.
- 5) Sitting arrangements of the Ld. P.P. and Panel A.P.P.s will be made in the Prashasan Bhavan as soon as the third floor of the building is completed and the payment of their due bill will also be made as soon as fund is received from the Govt.. The matter has already been moved to the Govt.. A.D.M. (G) will arrange to issue further reminder letter and to pursue the matter for allotment of such fund.
- 6) S.D.O. Bolpur and Rampurhat will also make sitting arrangements of Panel A.P.P.s and A.G.P.s in a suitable place of their office premises.
- 7) A workshop of I.O.s will be held with the Ld. P.P., Birbhum which will be arranged by the Supdt. of Police, Birbhum.
- 8) District Judge may be requested in the D.L.M.C. meeting in regard to posting of Addl. District Judge at Bolpur and the power of Asstt. District Judge, Bolpur may be obtained from the Judicial Deptt. or the Asstt. District Judge posted at Bolpur may be vested with the power of sitting in trial and sessions cases.


The Ld. District Judge will be requested to take up the matter of filling up of vacancy of Dubrajpur Court.

9) Contact No. in Mobile and Land Ph. with the names of Ld. P.P., Ld. A.G.P.s, A.P.P.s, Panel A.P.P.s, Ld. Judges, and Executive Magistrates have been collected. A Telephone diary will be prepared and it will be supplied to all concerned.

10) The Next monthly meeting will be held on 20/05/2011 at 03: 00 P.M. in the Conference Hall of Prashan Bhaban which will be presided over by the District Magistrate, Birbhum.

11) The performance report of the Panel A.P.P.s should be obtained before the meeting by A.D.M. (G) to review their performance.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to and from the chair.
